



Student's Right to Know Act 2019

According to Federal Regulations published by the U.S. Department of Education based on the Student Right-to-Know Act (SRTK), the STRK Graduation Rate is described as follows:

It is based upon students who entered as full-time, first-time freshman (no prior college experience) and graduated within 150% of the length of their program. The college is required to distribute this information to the entire student body. These rates are the graduation/completion data from Sumner College. The graduation/completion rates for the cohort of first-time, full-time student who entered school in full cohort 2015-2016 who graduated/completed within 150% of the normal time to complete the longest program.
