

High School Scholarship

Sumner College offers career-focused nursing programs in the healthcare fields. Sumner College has been preparing students in the Portland area since 1974. Our programs are designed to get you on the fast track to a stable and rewarding career. The college offers programs that are relevant in today's job market.

Sumner College developed its high school scholarship program for students who are interested in an additional opportunity to begin their academic career. Our primary goal is to provide students with the pertinent skills they need to gain a competitive edge over other applicants in their chosen career field.

This scholarship is offered to all high schools in Oregon and SW Washington. A maximum of four scholarships can be awarded to each school. Recipients of the award must enroll in the college and begin classes within six months to be eligible for the scholarship. The awards range from \$500 - \$1000, depending on the program of interest.

Amount: \$500 - \$1,000 (depending on program choice)

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a high school senior graduating in or after June.
- Applicant must be graduating from an accredited high school in Oregon or SW Washington (within 50 miles of the Sumner College campus).
- Students must enroll and start classes within 6 months of receiving the scholarship.

Deadline: June 30th for fall term & December 31st for spring term.

Application Requirements: Students interested in the Sumner College Scholarship must submit a typed 500 word essay.

- Applicant must submit a typed 500 word essay on why they are interested in their chosen career program and how this scholarship will help them achieve their goals.
- Completed application and essay must be submitted to the Director of Admissions. Recipients will be contacted by mail if selected.
- Applications without essays will not be considered.
